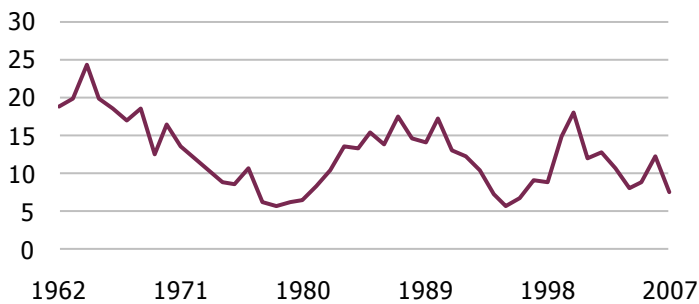


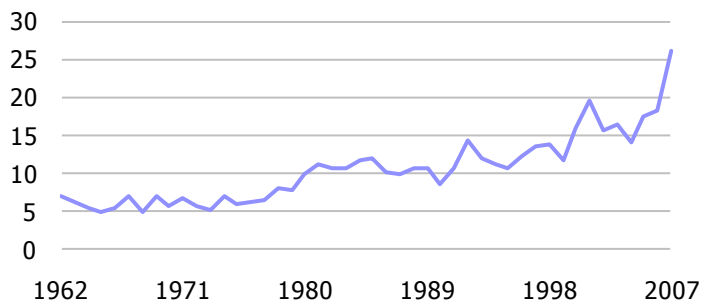
## Assistance to LAC

Percent of Total U.S. Economic Assistance



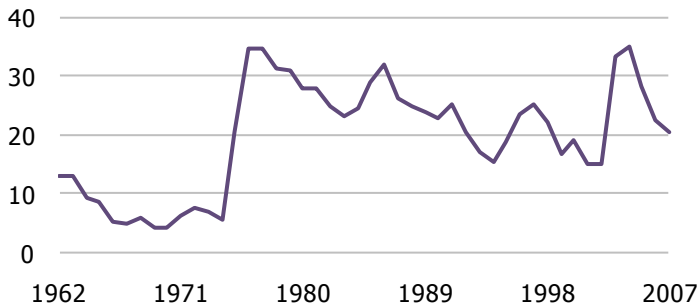
## Assistance to Sub Saharan Africa

Percent of Total U.S. Economic Assistance



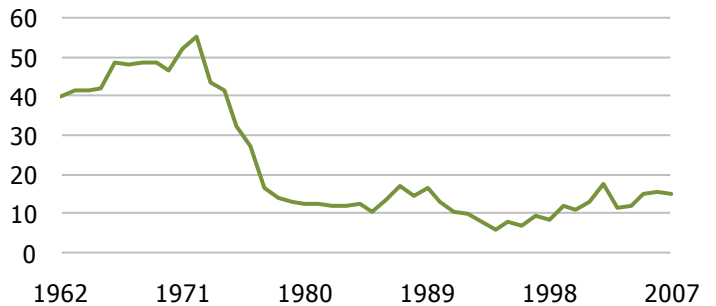
## Assistance to Middle East and N. Africa

Percent of Total U.S. Economic Assistance



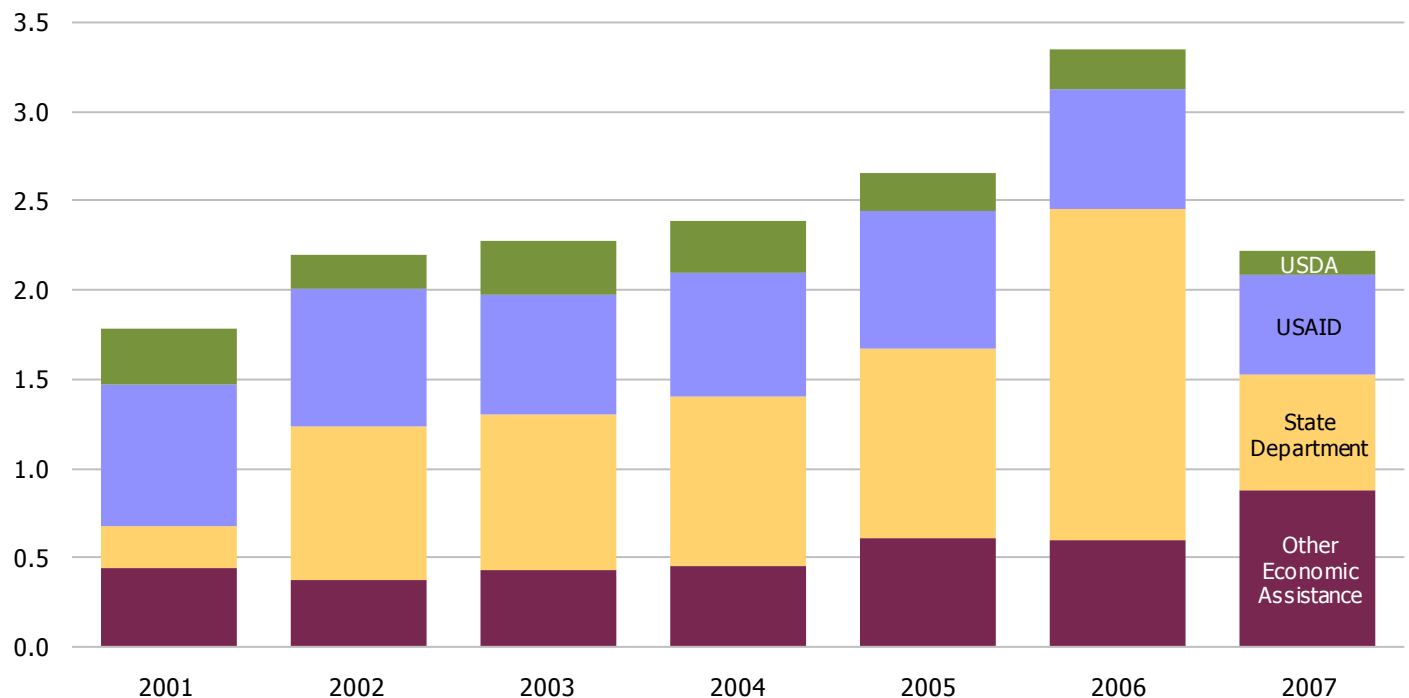
## Assistance to Asia and Oceania

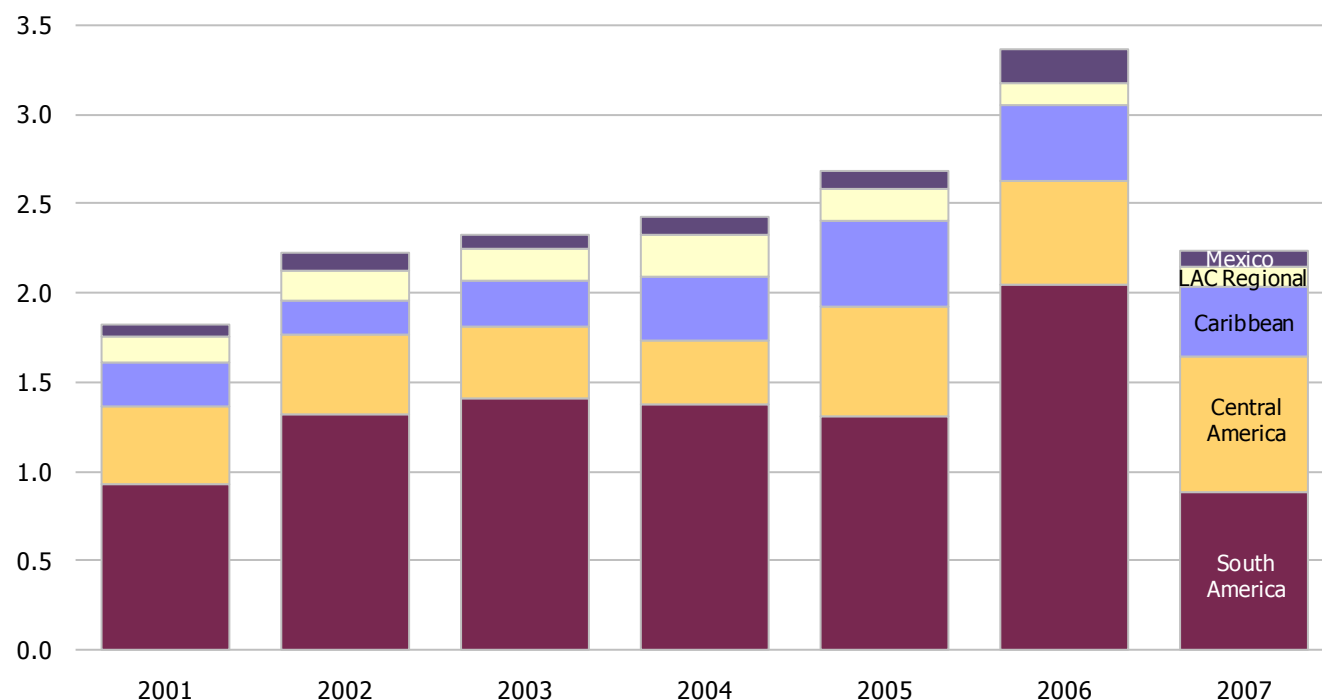

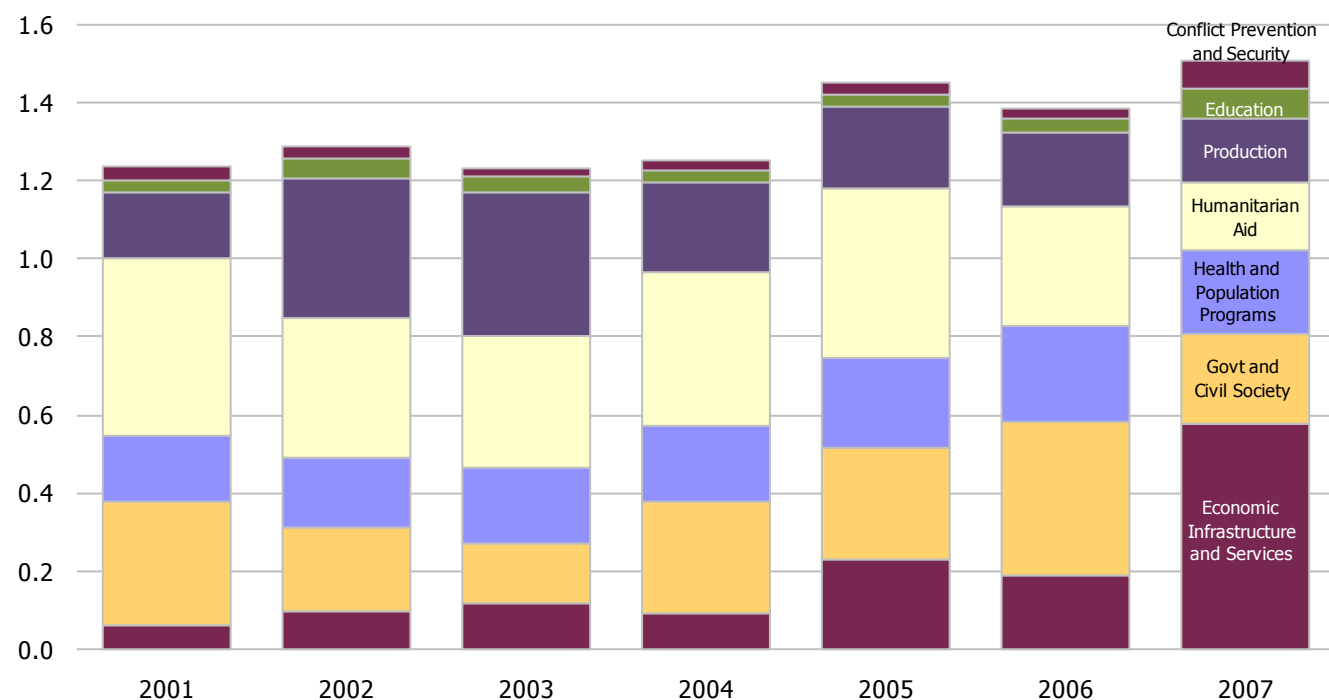

## Notes and Definitions

**Source** *U.S. Overseas Loans and Grants*, U.S. Agency for International Development, Washington, DC, 2008.

This section covers total commitments for economic (non-military) assistance funded by USAID, U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA), U.S. Department of State, and other U.S. Government agencies to the LAC region in each fiscal year. Commitments include loan authorizations and obligations, and grant obligations. Country-level data include some regional funds where such funds were directly allocated to field missions. Data are total obligations for each agency U.S. fiscal year, which ends September 30. *USAID* includes Economic Support Fund obligations, Development Assistance, Child Survival and Health, and other USAID assistance. *USDA* includes Food Aid and other USDA assistance. *State Department* includes the Global HIV/AIDS Initiative, Narcotics Control, Migration and Refugee Assistance, Nonproliferation, Anti-Terrorism, Demining & Related assistance, and other State Department assistance. *Other Economic Assistance* includes Peace Corps, Department of Defense Security Assistance, Millennium Challenge Corporation, and other active grant programs.

### U.S. Economic Assistance to LAC by Sector

**Definitions** Total U.S. economic assistance to Latin America and the Caribbean incorporates total U.S. Government non-military assistance to the Caribbean, Central America, South America, and Mexico. U.S. economic assistance funding is coded in the FADB to conform to the reporting requirements of both the *U.S. Overseas Loans and*

*Grants* (Greenbook) annual report to Congress and the U.S. Government's annual submission to the Development Assistance Committee (DAC) of the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD). Applying the DAC sector classifications to U.S. economic assistance funding as defined in the Greenbook, sector aggregations are made.

The *Conflict Prevention and Security* sector aggregation contains the DAC sector *Conflict Prevention and Resolution, Peace and Security*, which includes: assistance for security system management and reform; civilian peace-building, conflict prevention and resolution; support for United Nations post-conflict peace-building activities; reintegration of demobilized military personnel; land mine clearance; child soldier prevention and demobilization.

The *Economic Infrastructure and Services* sector aggregation is composed of DAC sectors *Banking and Financial Services, Business and Other Services, Communications, Energy Generation and Supply, and Transport and Storage*.

The *Education* sector aggregation contains the DAC sector *Education*, which includes: assistance for/to education policy and administrative management, education facilities and training, teacher training, and educational research where the level of education is unknown.

The *Government and Civil Society* aggregation contains DAC sector *Government and Civil Society, general*, which includes: assistance for economic and development policy/planning, public sector financial management, legal and judicial development, government administration, strengthening civil society, elections, human rights, free flow of information, and support of women's equality organizations and institutions.

The *Health and Population* sector aggregation is composed of DAC sector *Health* and DAC sector *Population Policies/Programs and Reproductive Health*, which include: assistance for health policy and administration management, medical education/training, medical research, medical services, assistance for population policy and administrative management, reproductive health care, family planning, STD control including HIV/AIDS, sector-specific personnel development.

The *Production* sector aggregation is composed of DAC sectors *Agriculture, Forestry, Fishing, Industry, and Mineral Resources and Mining*.

The *Humanitarian Aid* sector aggregation is composed of DAC sectors *Developmental Food Aid/Food Security Assistance, Emergency Response, Reconstruction Relief and Rehabilitation, Disaster Prevention and Preparedness, and Refugees in Donor Countries*.
